Title

- Names of authors come under the title with two lines space in Times New Roman 11 pt, italic. In the footnote quote first and last name of author, title, scientific position, institution

Abstract

- Abstracts are to be written in English
- Heading «Abstract» centered with two lines space under the authors name in Times New Roman 12 pt
- Abstract is to be written one line space from title in Times New Roman 11 pt, italic. 250 words maximum
- Key words come under the Abstract with one line space

Paper

- Paper is to be written in English in MS Word

- Page Format A4, fully justify. Page Margine: 2,8cm top, bottom, 2,5 left, right, header 2,1, footer 1,2
- Use font Times New Roman, 11 pt.
- Subtitles: centered, small letters, Times New Roman 12 pt, bold
- Maximum number of characters 30.000, apx. 10 pages with space single
