31th January 2013

Step1: Complete and send the application form before January 31th 2013

Step 2: You will receive by email and post the decision of pedagogical council

Step 3: If your application is accepted you must pay the first part of registration fee (250 Euros) before February 15th.

Step 4: You have to pay the remaining part of tuition fee (250 Euros) before February 28th 2013

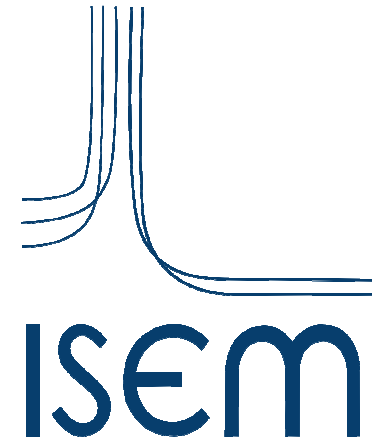
